- Declaration:
 - 96 per cent of books are never made available in large print, audio or braille.
 - Everyone has the right to read the same book, at the same time, at the same price.

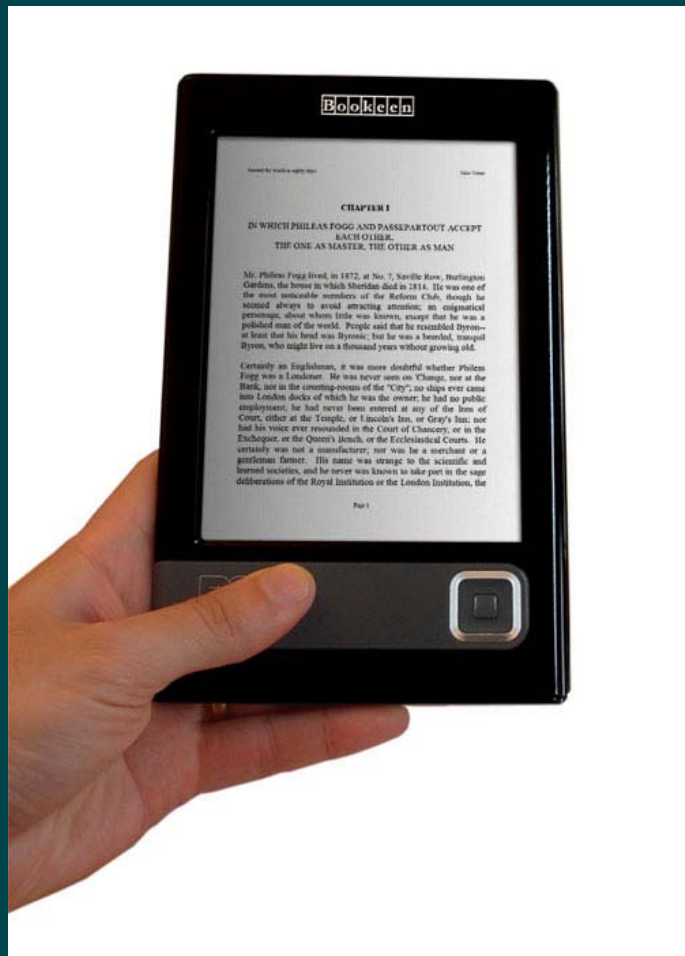
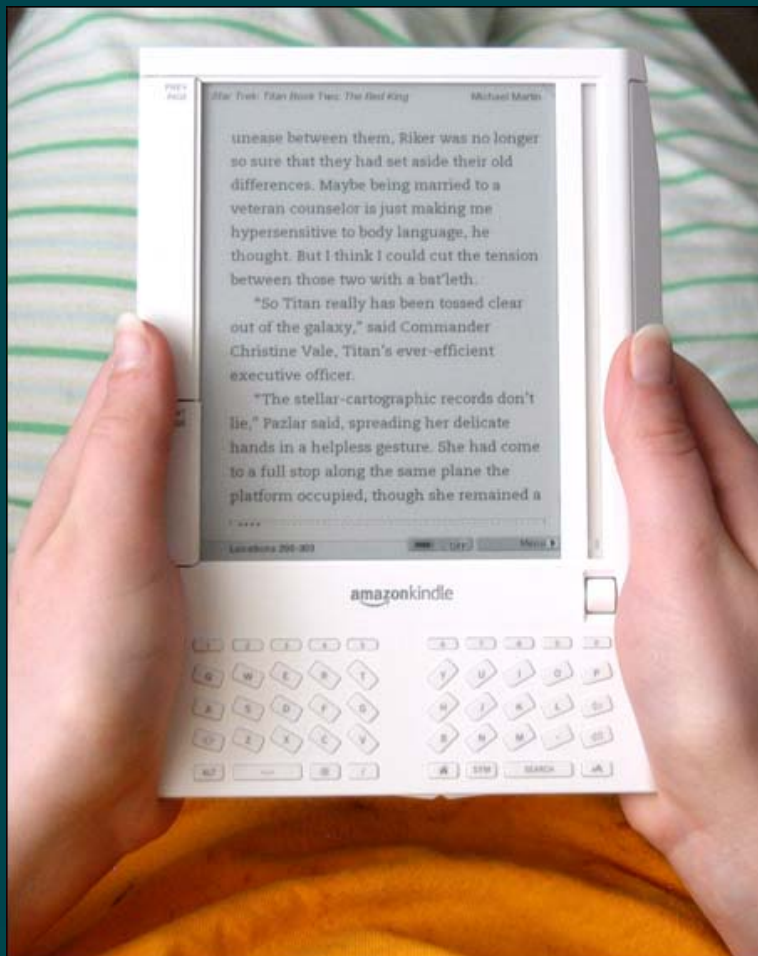
